- THE STORY:** Every so often in a Drummers life, usually when no one's looking, they will pick up a guitar and dream. Styx did. Then he moved to France. A year and a half later, Styx has a new e.p. "Let's Growl"

"In France, I have reinvented myself. For 1 ½ years I've been concentrating on the arts of song writing and solo performance. With my debut e.p. "AcouStyx" I was like a baby, studying my hands, my fingers and giggling. The songs were funny. With "Let's Growl" I am now a toddler. I'm standing up, looking around, in front of a stereo, learning to move, swinging my pants. And there is so much more to learn!"

Inspired by universal themes, the songs on this e.p. are more mature. They cover love, loss, unfulfilled dreams, social responsibility and being odd. Included is Styx's very first bi-lingual song "Hey Hey". There's also a nice range of production, from the fully produced pop anthem "Goodbye" to the ultra simple "I'm Satisfied" featuring just piano, guitar and voice.

All in all "Let's Growl" is a great step up and a celebration of all things Pop.
